2 RULES

- 2.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (RRS) and FIV Prescriptions 2025-2028.
- 2.2 Current FIV Regulations for National Sports Activities organized in Italy shall apply.
- 2.3 In case of a conflict between the NoR, SI and Official Notices, the SI and subsequent Official Notices will prevail. (This modifies RRS 63.5(c)).
- 2.4 The Appendix P will apply.
- 2.5 RRS 90.3 (e) will apply.

3 PLACE AND SCHEDULE

- 3.1 The event will be sailed in the bay of Naples.
- 3.2 Schedule:

Sunday	January 04, 2026	10:00 am, Coach Meeting 11:55 am, warning signal of the first race
Monday	January 05, 2026	Races
Tuesday	January 06, 2026	Races

- 3.3 The warning signal for the first race of the following days will be notify with a specific notice posted

on the ONB before 07:00 pm on the day it will take effect. If there is no notice, the same time of the first day will be maintained.

3.4 No warning signal can be given after **03:30 pm on January 06, 2026.**

The prizegiving ceremony will take place as soon as possible at the end of the event.

4.2 It is the responsibility of each competitor to have a device available that allows to access the Official Notice Board and submit their requests.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The SI will be available to competitors on the ONB by 03:00 pm, on the 3 of January 2026.

6 ELIGIBILITY

6.1 Marcello Campobasso Trophy is open to competitors sailing on boats of Optimist Class born between January, 1st 2011 and December 31st, 2017 as follows:

“DIVISION A” born in 2011-2012-2013-2014-2015 and

“DIVISION B” born in 2016-2017.

The Organization reserves to accept up to a maximum of 180 competitors.

A maximum of 8 athletes per Club will be allowed for Italian Clubs. For teams that exceed the number of 8 athletes there will be a waiting list that will be opened after registration closes.

6.2 All competitors shall be in compliance with the World Sailing eligibility rules.

7 FIV – AICO MEMBERSHIP (ONLY FOR ITALIAN SAILORS)

7.1 Italian competitors will be allowed to apply the event if in possession of the FIV card for the year 2025 with valid medical certificate and the class association card, valid for the current year.

Please note that the insurance taken out with AICO A.S.D. expires on 31/12/2025.

7.2 In agreement with the Italian Optimist Class Association, it will be possible, before the expiring, to renew membership and potential insurance in order to allow participation in the event.

7.3 These cards (class or class including ITAS insurance valid until 2025 and subsequent renewals) must be sent by e-mail at: infovela@ryccsavoia.it.

7.4 Foreign competitors must comply with all rules provided by their National Maritime Authority.

8 ENTRY PROCEDURE

8.1 Forms and Timing:

Registrations must be completed no later than 21st December 2025:

a) (EVERYBODY) filling the form available at the following link:

b) (ONLY ITALIAN COMPETITORS) registering for the event on the FIV CONINET platform on which the measurement certificates must be uploaded.

c) (EVERYBODY) sending the docs listed at par. 8.4.

8.2 Entry fee:

8.3 (ONLY ITALIAN COMPETITORS) GAN (National Competitive Group): For athletes belonging to the GAN, registration for the event is free of charge.

8.4 Documents:

The following documents must be sent **in a single e-mail** to the address: infovela@ryccsavoia.it indicating in subject – “Trofeo Campobasso 2026 (Sail Number)”:

- ✓ receipt of the entry fee;
- ✓ AICO valid membership (**ONLY ITALIAN COMPETITORS**);
- ✓ measurement certificate;
- ✓ third-party liability insurance valid with a minimum coverage of € 1.500.000,00, as per FIV regulations.

9 MEASUREMENTS CERTIFICATES

9.1 RRS 78 it will apply.

9.2 Boats must have a valid Certificate of Measurement or Conformity.

9.3 Competitors must compete with boats, sails and equipment regularly measured and it will not be possible to replace the sail without the authorization of the TC or, if not appointed, by the RC.

9.4 All boats must sail with the sail number shown on the measurement certificate.

9.5 Any changes may be authorized by the TC only in the event of breakage or damage, subject to verification of the damage by the TC or, in his absence, by the RC.

10 MEASUREMENTS CHECKS

Measurement checks will be made at the discretion of the TC.

11 NUMBER OF RACES, RESULTS AND DISCARDS

11.1 A total of 9 races will be sailed for both DIVISION A and DIVISION B.

11.2 It will be sailed no more than 3 races per day for both DIVISION A and DIVISION B.

11.3 It will apply the RRS Appendix “A”.

11.4 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11.5 The event is valid with any number of races sailed.

12 FORMAT OF THE REGATTA

12.1 Division A: the regatta will take place with the split-fleet system as described in Addendum A of the SI.

Division B: single fleet regatta.

12.2 Qualifying series (Division A): on the first two days, races will be sailed with the “A” split-fleet system (two colours). If at the end of the first two days a total minimum of 4 races have NOT been completed, the format will continue with the split-fleet regattas.

12.3 Final series (Division A): if the qualifying series has been completed, on the last day the competitors will be divided into two fleets, one “GOLD” and one “SILVER”. The final series will consist of a maximum of 3 races.

13 SUPPORT PERSON

All Support Persons (coaches / parents / guardians) must be accredited by filling out the registration

form available at the following link:

<https://forms.gle/k1t8enJTKxUzeDMb9> by the 23rd December 2025 declaring:

- A) the characteristics of your assistance rib;
- B) acceptance of the "Rules for assistance boats of Support Persons" described in the SI;
- C) the sail numbers of the accompanied competitors;
- D) to be in possession of VHF.

Accredited support persons will be subject to the technical and disciplinary directives of the RC and the Jury which, if it will be required, will be able to act in compliance with RRS 62.3 and 62.4.

14 PRIZES

- 14.1 The overall winner of each race and the first five competitors on the total scoring list will receive a prize.
- 14.2 THE MARCELLO CAMPOBASSO TROPHY "Division A"
The Marcello Campobasso Trophy will be awarded to the competitor first classified in Division A.
- 14.3 THE UNICEF TROPHY "Division B"
The UNICEF Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the competitor first classified in Division B.
- 14.4 THE BRANKO STANČIČ CUP
The "Branko Stančič" Cup will be awarded to the competitor coming from the farthest Yacht Club.
- 14.5 THE IRENE CAMPOBASSO PLATE
The "Irene Campobasso" Plate will be awarded to the first female competitor classified in Division "A".
- 14.6 THE LAURA ROLANDI PLATE
The Plate will be awarded to the Italian Club that will get the best score obtained by adding the two best scoring of its athletes in the final list between Division "A" and Division "B".

15 ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

It is recalled the Basic Principle which states: "Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing", it is recommended that care be taken to protect the environment at all times during and after the event. Especially attention is drawn to RRS 47 -Trash Disposal - which states: "Competitors and support persons shall not intentionally put trash in the water. This rule applies at all times while afloat. The penalty for a breach of this rule may be less than disqualification".

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." Therefore, the participants are aware that the sailing activity falls within those governed by art. 2050 of the Italian Civil Code and that all participants must have a valid FIV membership that guarantees accident coverage, including death and permanent disability. Foreign competitors must comply with any requirements of their MNA and be in possession of accident coverage including death and permanent disability, as per current FIV regulations.

17 MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in this championship, a competitor grants to the organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use, and show at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures, and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the championship, and of all of his or her material related to the championship, without compensation.

18 LOGISTIC

For competitors who come from outside Naples and need to stop, parking is available at the Naval Base of the Navy Headquarters in Via Acton 1.

You will need to register at the following link: <https://forms.gle/M6t9nimAkGGe9u2u8> , specifying the date of arrival and departure, the plate of vans/cars/ trailers.

All this information must be submitted no later than December 23rd, 2025.

18.1 Competitors from other countries:

For each nation taking part in the trophy, apart from Italy, Circolo Savoia guarantees hotel accommodation (reimbursement up to 75€/per competitor/per day, to be understood as the number of days of the event) and one Optimist boat for free to the first 3 young sailors each, in order of applying.

To the other participants **it will be possible to rent an Optimist for the amount of 350€ per boat, for the entire duration of the competition.**

In order to ensure the proper organization of the event, every competitor (or who's in charge) coming without a personal boat and wants a boat supplied by Savoia YC (for free if is entitled to it or for hire) shall fill the **"BOAT REQUEST FORM"** available here: <https://forms.gle/7EYwZK2KceGX8jBMA> within **12nd December 2025**.

The RO will confirm the boat assignment or their unavailability as soon as possible.
